Leadership Longmont is a six-month course of study designed to educate current and aspiring leaders about the critical issues and opportunities facing the community. A representative group of 20-25 individuals from business, government, education and non-profit organizations will be selected to participate. A written application is required. The program is open to everyone who is interested in contributing their skills, knowledge and expertise to the betterment of the Longmont community.

- Tuition for Leadership Longmont is \$440. Tuition covers all course materials, assigned books, guest lecturers, tours, meals and meeting space. Tuition may be paid by the candidate's employer, a sponsor, or the candidate.
- **The deadline for application is Noon, December 3, 2015.** Candidates will receive a confirmation notice by December 18, 2015.
- The Leadership Longmont Class of 2016 will meet on the first Wednesday of the month from January – June 2016 from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. each day. **See attached list of dates.**

FAQ

What Is Leadership Longmont?

Leadership Longmont is a dynamic course of study, conducted in a seminar format, which focuses on critical issues and opportunities facing the local community.

Who should attend Leadership Longmont?

Anyone who is currently in a leadership position, or aspiring to participate in a leadership role in the community, including government office, boards of directors, business owners, or key business executives. Previous graduates have pursued public office, served on or chaired boards of directors, plus headed major companies or their own small businesses.

When is the program sessions conducted?

Leadership Longmont courses will be conducted on first or second Wednesday of the month between January and June. Program sessions are scheduled from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Some days may be modified to accommodate special learning opportunities, academic lectures or site tours.

What is the Leadership Longmont 2016 Course of Study?

Exciting plans are being solidified to feature: Understanding Your City Government; Healthcare in the 21st Century; Media Communication and Leadership Class Projects.

Where will the program sessions be held?

Most program sessions will be held at St. Vrain Valley School District, Administration Building at 395 South Pratt Parkway. Based on the day's curriculum, meetings may be conducted at various sites throughout the community.

How much is the tuition?

The 2016 program tuition is \$440 per person. The fee includes all course materials, assigned books, guest lecturers, tours, meals and meeting space.

How many candidates are selected?

Typically 20 – 25 candidates make up a Leadership Longmont class. A conscious effort is made to seek out representation from a cross section of business segments including government, education, labor, media, health care, banking, and private enterprise.

How do I apply?

Applications may be obtained from the Longmont Area Chamber of Commerce by e-mail or hard copy. Applications are being accepted from October 20 – December 3, 2015 and should be submitted to The Chamber. Candidates will be notified by December 18th.
